This is our seventh annual conference, and we have come a long way from our first, that I recall clearly as if it was yesterday. It started as an idea discussed befittingly in the operating room. Our theme was 'Complications', and our first keynote speaker was Henry Marsh, who had just published what was to become one of the most famous surgical humanities book of all time. The format is hybrid (part physical and mostly virtual), for reasons of both safety and convenience.

Like previous years, we have once again collaborated with the Journal of Pakistan Medical Association (JPMA), and published a special supplement on the conference with 26 papers on Surgical Research. We are also publishing a book titled, 'Evolution of Surgical Specialties in Pakistan: Chronicles from the Theatres and Beyond', that narrates little known facts about the beginnings of surgical specialties in Pakistan. This book, we foresee, will be an invaluable resource for all surgeons and medical history buffs, and will be a must-have for everyone related to healthcare in Pakistan.

There are 16 pre and post conference ACCME accredited workshops as part of the conference, centered around the theme. The scientific program is a mix of lectures, talks, panel discussions, a debate, and a residents' quiz, and not just covers most aspects of surgical research, but also includes future directions for surgeons working in developing countries. There are also specialized student-led and nurse-led sessions that have filled the void that persisted in our previous conferences. All workshops, courses and scientific sessions are accredited by the ACCME. 





Orations

Ali al-Ḥusayn Ibn-e-Sina



Ali al-Ḥusayn Ibn-e-Sina, also known as Avicenna was a Persian polymath who is regarded as one of the most significant thinkers and writers of the Islamic Golden Age. Regarded as the Father of Medicine, his most famous works are The Book of Healing – a philosophical and scientific encyclopaedia, and a five-volume medical encyclopaedia: The Canon of Medicine which became a standard medical text at many universities and remained in use as late as 1650. Besides philosophy and medicine, Avicenna's corpus includes

writings on astronomy, alchemy, geography and geology, psychology, Islamic theology, logic, mathematics, physics and poetry.

Abu al-Qasim al-Zahrawi



Abu al-Qasim al-Zahrawi, also known as Albucasis, is considered the Father of Surgery. His outstanding contribution to medicine is his encyclopaedic work The Kitab Al-Tasrif, a long and detailed work in thirty treatises. The book contains the earliest pictures of surgical instruments and of all the contents of this landmark publication, the part on surgery became the most famous and had by far the greatest influence. In it, he developed all aspects of surgery and its various branches, including ophthalmology, ear, nose, and

throat, head and neck, general surgery, obstetrics and gynaecology, military medicine, urology, and orthopaedics. This was a standard text well into the 1700s and was taught to medical students at major universities in Europe until the late 1800s.

Ibn Zakariya al-Razi



Ibn Zakariya al-Razi, also known by his Latinized name Rhazes. al-Razi was considered a shaikh, an honorary title given to one entitled to teach and surrounded by several circles of students. al-Razi's medical works and ideas became known among medieval European practitioners and profoundly influenced medical education in the Latin West. Some volumes of his work Al-Mansuri, namely "On Surgery" and "A General Book on Therapy", became part of the medical curriculum in Western universities. Al-Razi was one of

the world's first great medical experts. He wrote more than 224 books on various subjects. His most important work is the medical encyclopedia known as Al-Hawi fi al-Tibb, known in Europe as Liber Continens. He is considered the father of psychology and psychotherapy.
